Keep Crackin' Those Eggs!

Please remember to keep crackin' those eggs over the summer.

- Throughout the year, as you use eggs, crack them on the narrow end and leave approximately a half-dollar sized hole
- Wash them with warm water and rinse well
- Dry them upside down

If you wish to stuff the eggs then:

- Once dry, half fill the eggs with confetti
- Use a half page of permanent wave/perm paper (we can provide) and attach with very watery water glue
- Allow to dry, send to school in original container

Important Immunization Changes for 2009-2010 School Year



Important modifications will be made by the State of LA Dept. of Health & Hospitals affecting school age children for the next school year. Please note the below summary and ensure that your child is up to date with the current requirements. These requirements are in addition to those vaccines already required by the State.

Middle School Requirement:

All students entering the sixth grade or who has attained the age of 11 years old, must show evidence of current immunization against meningococcal disease. This requirement also affects susceptible individuals through 18 years of age who are enrolled in any LA school.

Kindergarten/First Time Enterers:

Two doses of varicella vaccine (chickenpox) will be required in LA schools for entry into PreK3, PreK4, and Kindergarten.

Please have your child's immunizations up to date prior to beginning school in August. Also request an up to date immunization record from your physician and send to the school office after receiving these vaccines.
