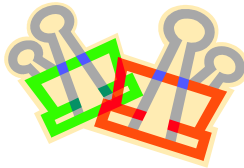
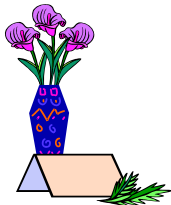

Meals in Ministry at St. Catherine of Siena School

Serving God Through Serving Others

What is Meals in Ministry?

Through a team of wonderful volunteers, we provide meals to school families in times of need – both happy and sad, such as after the birth of a new baby in the absence of close family, a surgery or hospitalization, illness and during times of crisis.

How Does It Work?

The Meals in Ministry coordinators are made aware of a need, either through a direct request for help or through the referral by someone within the school. Volunteers are then contacted and asked to provide a meal (home cooked or purchased) and deliver it to the recipient's home. Often, the homeroom class will be solicited for assistance when the need arises. However, if you would like to be included, irrespective of the grade level, please email us and we will place your name in our file.

How Can You Help?

Meals in Ministry is an excellent way to meet other people from school and make a difference in someone's life, with a minimal time commitment. Meals DO NOT have to be homemade. In situations such as these, it is definitely "the thought that counts." The purpose is to help someone in need by providing a helping hand in meal preparation, not to dazzle anyone with your culinary skills. In times of need, a friendly face and a meal is a true gift.

Meal Guidelines:

- We provide a complete meal and deliver it to the recipient's home.
- It can be store bought, homemade, frozen or just about anything!
- The meal does not have to be fancy or gourmet.
- We attempt to accommodate allergies and food preferences.
- We strive to work out a schedule that benefits the recipient the most while working with the schedule of the volunteer.
